4.3 Stacy Romero w/Broussard Chamber of Commerce

Re-cap of Independence Day Celebration

Stacy gave a re-cap of the largest annual community event. They began planning on July 5, 2022, for this year's event. This was the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July event. We hosted approximately 21,300 guests. 75% of those were local and 25% were visitors that traveled from 14 states. The event cost \$74,367 to host. The Chamber had \$55,000 to host the event and the remaining balance was paid by soliciting sponsorships. The return was huge. 1.28 million was spent near St Julien Park on that day, putting us in the #1 spot for taxable revenues in the parish around that day. She thanked the Mayor and Council, the Fire and Police Department, the City Workers and the BEDC Board. She read an email from a visitor who attended the event, stating how great this event was. She looks forward to planning these events. Nov 2<sup>nd</sup> will be Music on Main with the Chee Weez and Dec 2 will be the Christmas Parade and Noel a' Broussard. Mayor Bourque thanked Stacy and her team for putting on such a great event.

He stated the city is doing great things, with such a great Mayor and Council and Chief. Mr. Ardoin stated they have great people and a great criminal lab also, but they don't have a great building. They were operating out of the basement of the tower at the Lafayette airport. Now they are in an old metal building, which they have been in for 34 years. This resolution will allow them to get Capital Outlay funds to build a 40,000 square foot facility next to their current facility. Working together with all other departments this commits to matching funds from each department. Fund requirements would be a 25% match. When they went to the legislature for the funding, they said to get the match from municipalities. The fund match is based on the 2019 cases and the City of Broussard's share would be \$30,611. They are here tonight to ask for the city's support by adopting this resolution. Councilman Regan questioned where the new building will be built? Ardoin stated it will

be at 5004 Admiral Doyle in New Iberia. Chief Olivier questioned if this is a one-time fee? Ardoin stated yes, based on the 2019 cases

Discussion: Mayor Bourque stated that over the last several years we have been trying to find better accommodation for the police department to work out of. They have worked with planners, but the cost of a new building would be 9 million dollars. So, we started searching for a new avenue. A complex off Highway 90 at 5801 and Bercegeay Road has come available. They have worked with the council committee on this property that will work for the police, fire, and public works. It will serve as a police station, fire department, fire admin building, and a public works headquarters consolidated on one piece of property. The police department building is 23,600 on 1.41 acres. The 3 other buildings are 60,600 square feet combined on 10 acres for a total of 11.65 acres. We have done our due diligence and inspections. The purchase price of all the properties is 5.3 million. We are coming out way ahead and keeping up with the Broussard growth. Chief Olivier stated he is very excited about this. It is currently hard for our officers to work sharing offices. This will be overall good for retention and recruitment. We will have more space than we need, but it is needed. They will also have enough room to host classes. Deputy Chief Denais stated they are also very excited about this. Currently the station on Main Street does not have adequate living quarters and this will be a big asset for them. Currently the Main Street and First Street Station overlap. This new building will replace the Main Street building and will cover the St. Martin area. This will be a huge upgrade with response and office space. He thanked the mayor and council for this huge investment. Mel echoed what Deputy Chief Denais said. Currently they have no place to store their equipment on the Southside. This will enable them to also be directly underneath the water tower.

They can also store equipment there and this will enable them to get to emergencies quicker on that side. Mayor Bourque thanked the leadership package and the council for going to see the facility. Everyone pulled together on this project.

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROUSSARD, LOUISIANA, TO AMEND THE 2021/2022 OPERATING BUDGET OF REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES TO INCREASE AUTHORIZED EXPENDITURES FOR THE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY ON HIGHWAY 90

WHEREAS, the welfare of the citizens of the City of Broussard, Louisiana would best be served by acquisition of certain property on Highway 90 in the City of Broussard; and

WHEREAS, the Broussard City Council desires to amend the 2023/2024 Operating Budget of Revenues and Expenditures to authorize expenditures for said acquisition.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Broussard, Louisiana, that the 2023/2024 Operating Budget of Revenues and Expenditures be amended to authorize expenditures of Five Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars for acquisition of property located on Highway 90 and Bercegeay Drive in the City; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Broussard, Louisiana, that the 2023/2024 Operating Budget of Revenues and Expenditures be further amended to authorize expenditures of up to Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to fund expenses associated with the acquisition of said property including, without limitation inspections, appraisals, legal fees, and other acquisition expenses.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Broussard, Louisiana that authority for acquisition of the Highway 90 and Bercegeay Drive is conditioned on completions of inspections and satisfaction as to the overall condition of the property and improvements.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Broussard, Louisiana that the Mayor is authorized to proceed with necessary inspections, to obtains estimates for costs of necessary repairs, and to accept the condition of the property to be purchased.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Broussard, Louisiana that the Mayor is authorized to proceed with the said purchase and to execute such documents as he deems appropriate to carry out the foregoing.
