#### 3.1 Resolution #663-21

Discussion: Mayor Bourque stated that a representative from DOTD stated there needs to be a turn lane added near Fezzo's. DOTD stated they would fund it and put in a turn lane, but they cannot do it if it is a private road. Mayor Bourque stated he spoke to one of the owners and they will approve the donation of the entrance road to the city. Mel stated they did core samples of the roadway and it does meet our standards. Mayor Bourque stated he knows there were talks in the past to do this, because we do have property near the test well site. We are beginning to look at this road extension again.

#### 4.3 Ordinance #21-689

An ordinance amending the 2020/2021 Operating Budget of Revenues and Expenditures for \$130,000 for Waterline Improvements from Highway 90 to Lake Talon Road along Southwood Drive and Cruise Avenue to add a 12-Inch waterline with 50% to be reimbursed by the developer

Discussion: Mayor Bourque stated that Comeaux Engineering met with the Fire Department to make sure this plan would work. We currently have deficiencies in this area. It will be a second waterline in that area for the target building, Loadmaster. Once done there will be new hydrants in that area. There will be a 6

inch and a 12-inch line. This will be adequate for the development in that area. The developer is agreeing to the 50% reimbursement. Councilman Regan questioned if we can use the stimulus money for reimbursement for this? Mayor Bourque stated he does not know the procedures yet for the stimulus money. We will get that around May 11<sup>th</sup> alone with guidelines for the dates. Councilman Higginbotham stated we also need to see about getting Cruise Drive re-surfaced, the road is in pretty bad shape. Councilman Bonin stated when we do overlay the road, maybe we can beef up the construction on it, because of the large vehicles that will now be using it. Mayor Bourque stated we are developing a list of roads to be overlayed for our upcoming budget and he will add this one to the list.
