#### 3.2 Resolution #720-22

The City of Broussard City Council agrees to accept ownership of whatever rights the State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development including, but not limited to, all future operation, maintenance, and repairs associated therewith, for its operation and maintenance as a city street for the portion of state route LA 182 (known as East Main Street) from its junction with the local road known as Albertson's Parkway proceeding south approximately 0.485 miles to its junction with the local road known as Saint Etienne Road

Discussion: Mayor Bourque stated this is currently a state road. This section was improved when Albertson Parkway was done. This will be included in the right sizing of Highway 182. 
