Right now when you come to a stop at that intersection, it is at a steep angle. To deem it safe you will need to come in at a 90% angle. Marino gave the council a design map showing the realignment of the intersection onto Main Street. The intent is to show how the road will come thru this property in the future. Mayor Bourque stated the building is currently abandoned and has been for more than 5 years. The family is willing to sell the property, but the property is divided between 2 families.
